# Regulations for Irish Historical Research Prize 2013

The National University of Ireland is pleased to invite applications for the Irish Historical Research Prize, offered for competition in 2013.

## 1. Value of a Prize

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The Prize, valued at €5,000, will be awarded for the best new work of Irish historical research, published as a sole publication by a graduate of the National University of Ireland.

## 2. Eligibility

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- 2.1 Applicants will be graduates of the National University of Ireland, normally of doctoral status, and senior history scholars, well established in their field of expertise. They will have a substantial body of research that has been peer-reviewed and published widely both nationally and internationally.
- 2.2 Works eligible to be considered for the 2013 Prize will have been published in the period April 2010 to March 2013. Works previously entered for the Prize are not eligible for consideration.
- 2.3 The work submitted for this Prize should be substantial and must be of an original character indicating direct research in historical records.

## 3. Application Procedure

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Application forms are available to download at [www.nui.ie/awards](http://www.nui.ie/awards) and should be submitted with the following:

- 3.1 Six copies of the publication in hard-copy.
- 3.2 **Curriculum Vitae:** to include academic and other relevant achievements to date.

*Please note that publications submitted as entries for the competition will not be returned.*

## 4. Selection Process

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A Panel of experts representing each of the constituent universities and chaired by the NUI Chancellor will make a recommendation to the Senate on the awarding of the Prize. The decision of the Senate will be final.
