Regulations governing the Irish Historical Research Prize

The National University of Ireland is pleased to invite applications for the Irish Historical Research Prize, offered for competition in 2019.

1.	Value of the Prize
	The Prize, valued at \notin 7,500, will be awarded for the best new work of Irish historical research, published as a sole publication by a graduate of the National University of Ireland. This Prize is for senior scholars, and has been awarded to some of Ireland's most eminent historians.
2.	Eligibility
	 2.1 Applicants will be graduates of the National University of Ireland, normally of doctoral status, and senior history scholars, well established in their field of expertise. They will have a substantial body of research that has been peerreviewed and published widely both nationally and internationally. 2.2 Works eligible to be considered for the 2019 Prize will have been published in the period April 2016 to March 2019. Works previously entered for the Prize are not eligible for consideration.
	2.3 The work submitted for this Prize should be substantial and must be of an original character indicating direct research in historical records.
	2.4 Applicants can only apply for either the Publication Prize in Irish History or the Irish Historical Research Prize in any given year.
3.	Application Procedure
	Application forms are available to download at www.nui.ie/awards and should be submitted with the following documentation:
	3.1 Six copies of the publication in hard-copy;
	3.2 Curriculum Vitae: to include academic and other relevant achievements to date.
4.	Selection Process
	A panel of experts representing each of the constituent universities and chaired by the NUI Chancellor will make a recommendation to the Senate on the awarding of the Prize. The decision of the Senate will be final.
