NUI is committed to upholding and implementing the principles of equality, diversity and inclusion in all its activities.

NUI's annual programme of scholarships, fellowships, prizes and grants seeks to recognise, reward and support academic and wider scholarly achievements. We welcome applications from all students and scholars who meet the academic eligibility criteria for each competition. We particularly welcome applications from eligible students and scholars in groups that are under-represented in Irish Higher Education, noting the following protected characteristics: gender, marital status, family status, socioeconomic status, age, disability, sexual orientation, race, religion, and membership of the Traveller community.
